Footnotes

STORMY SURGE broke alertly and took back off the leaders from the rail, moved closer into the second turn, eased outside MALLINSON ROAD entering the stretch, rallied to the lead at the furlong pole and drew clear driving. MALLINSON ROAD (NZ) dueled early from the inside, edged clear on the second turn, met the winner s bid but could not match strides in the lane. KNOCKOUT ARTIST raced unhurried early while two wide to the backstretch, offered his best bid four wide on the second turn and flattened out in the lane. QUASICOBRA was not asked for speed early, raced three wide to the stretch and went evenly through the lane. NORTHERN J C was void of any early speed, saved ground throughout and was never a factor. MOVE OVER MARINO settled early from the rail, advanced three wide on the second turn but came up empty in the lane. KNIGHTSEN dueled outside MALLINSON ROAD for a half mile and stopped.
