Footnotes

DEAL BREAKER (GB) broke alertly and prompted VOTE from the outset, moved up outside that rival in the upper stretch to challenge for the lead past the furlong pole and proved best driving. VOTE set all of the pace from the inside to the furlong pole and slackened late. FIRE BREAK stalked the top two from just off the rail to the stretch and lacked the needed response. EL CUGAT settled early on the rail, came two wide to the stretch and closed a minor gap only. CAPTAIN ROY lagged early from the inside, commenced his bid from the three path on the second turn and finished willingly. SPORT KING raced unhurried early, saved ground throughout and was never a factor. FORM A POSSE lacked early speed then was eased on the second turn but walked off.
