DUNMORE EAST was clear in the opening strides then permitted OUR NAUTIQUE (NZ) to set the pace, bid into the second turn while two wide, was kept at bay to inside the furlong grounds but dug in late and raced clear. OUR NAUTIQUE (NZ) set a soft pace for five furlongs, resisted the winner on the second turn, dug in to deep stretch but was outfinished in the final sixteenth. SKIPSHOT tracked the pace for a half mile, offered his best run three wide on the second turn but could not sustain that bid and flattened. HIGHWAY BANDIT saved ground while being settled for a half mile, closed the gap on the second turn from the rail but lost his punch through the drive. JEBRICA was three wide while chasing the top two for five furlongs, swung out four wide into the stretch but gave way in the lane.
