Footnotes

SHEEKEY (IRE) broke in stride was permitted to sit back just off the leader, moved up three wide to gain command at the quarter pole, dueled until inside the furlong pole then gradually edged clear driving. DON'T ANSWER was permitted to settle early, moved up two wide and between foes on the turn and finished steadily. SAXMAN was not asked for speed early, commenced his bid on the turn, was fanned four wide into the stretch to loom a factor but lost his punch. DR. J J raced close up from the rail, steadied inside DON'T ANSWER at the five sixteenth pole to fall from contention but finished willingly in the lane. SIDEPOCKET LOU lacked good early speed, saved ground and came on without being a serious factor. ALBACORE BOB prompted the pace between horses, remained a factor inside the winner at the furlong pole but gave way suddenly. SWISS ALPINE raced up inside in the early stages to take command, was headed from the rail into the lane and had little left.
