CAHILL CHROME had the best speed, set all the pace to the second turn, was headed by NO TEAM SPIRIT between calls but took back the advantage at the quarter pole, kicked away to mid stretch then held off ROVING STORM late. ROVING STORM was unhurried for a half mile, rallied three wide on the second turn then finished willingly but was too late. BLUEGRASS CHAPP saved ground throughout but lacked a closing response. OUTDOORSMAN GENE had no speed, tried to rally three wide on the second turn but came up empty. NO TEAM SPIRIT tracked the pace to the half, offered a rally inside the winner and inched to a half length advantage between calls on the second turn but was quickly headed by the latter into the stretch and weakened. GAEL MANIA chased the pace to the second turn, raced two wide to the stretch but gave way in the drive. IMA KOOL STAR prompted the pace for just over a half mile, gave out on the second turn and stopped in the stretch.
