TWO THIRDS VICTORY was always a pace factor, dueled two wide on the second turn, put away SUKARA into the stretch but was immediately confronted and headed by the runnerup, battled gamely under vigorous handling and came back on to get the decision. CAL BAYERS trailed to half, commenced a bid nearing the second turn, circled four wide to the stretch, pushed to the front in mid stretch, could not shake loose and hung late to give up the advantage. ASTUZIA tracked the pace to the second turn, rallied three wide to the stretch then was outfinished in the final furlong. JEWEL SEEKER was unhurried to the second turn, tried to rally three deep to the stretch but was not a threat. SEVENTYPRCENTCOCOA settled in the opening quarter mile from the rail, raced unhurried down the backstretch, was asked for more two deep on the second turn but came up empty in the drive. SUKARA set the pace for six furlongs, briefly resisted the winner to the stretch but tired in the drive. SWEETRAYOFSUNSHINE stalked the pace from the rail to the second turn then gave out.
