SUDDEN EXCESS lugged out while showing speed, was three wide to the backstretch, set the pace to the second turn, remained three wide to the stretch then dug in gamely and held. IRISH HARMONY was fanned four wide while prompting the winner to the backstretch, continued in good position to the second turn, was four wide to the stretch then drifted out through the drive and could not catch the top one. MORAL HAZARD broke a step slow, lagged to the half, offered his best bid four wide to the stretch but lost his punch in the drive. COURT RULE tracked the pace to the half, was two wide to the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. AFFIRMINATOR was allowed to settle for a half mile, raced three wide to the stretch then gave way in the drive. TUCANNON chased the pace to the second turn but lacked a closing response.
