Footnotes

TOP OF THE RAINBOW was bumped between horses at the start and fell back to trail to the turn, came three wide to the stretch, swung to the extreme outside for the drive and offered a bold rally to get up late and won going away. LUCKY AFFAIR broke into the winner at the start but recovered and stalked the leaders early, eased three wide and between horses nearing the quarter pole to be challenging for command once in the stretch, drew well clear in mid stretch but could not quite last. NATURAL PEARL was always close up from the outside, came four wide to the stretch, rallied to the deep stretch and lost some of her punch. STORM SWEEPER was bumped by the winner at the start and lacked early speed, raced two wide on the turn, eased out for the drive and finished steadily without being a serious factor. DARLING DISARRAY dueled two wide to the upper stretch and faded. LA INDIA ELEGANT stalked the pace from the outset, had her best bid three wide into the lane and weakened. MISS SMOKE SIGNALS raced unhurried early, was four wide on the turn and did not rally. VALID VIXEN was hustled from the inside to duel for the lead to mid turn and stopped. GYPSY MARY saved ground to no avail.
