### Footnotes

SNOWBOUND SAILOR broke slow and was not hurried early, came through inside on the turn to reach contention once in the stretch, eased out near the sixteenth pole, offered a late surge to split CAZADERO and LOCKSMITH late, collared MALIBU'S REFRAIN near the wire and won going away driving. MALIBU'S REFRAIN stumbled at the start but quickly recovered to set the pace from the inside, met bids at the furlong pole, edged away again but could not hold the winner. LOCKSMITH stalked the pace three wide to the deep stretch but lacked a solid closing response. CAZADERO pressed the pace two wide throughout and weakened late. ABSOLUTE MAGNITUDE was well positioned just off the leaders, cared in the two path to the stretch but failed to rally. SMOKELISH settled early, raced three wide on the turn and lacked a rally. RED DIRT lacked good early speed, advanced from the rail to the stretch and lost his punch. DOWN RIVER ROAD raced unhurried early and failed to respond while two wide into the stretch. TREADWELL showed little. GO GUS GO had no speed.
