EMA BOVARY (CHI) broke cleanly and tracked the dueling leaders under a snug hold, continued under strong restraint on the turn while caught behind the wall of leaders, swung out for the drive, split horses in the upper stretch to take command quickly and drew off without ever being asked for her best. DEVIL DANCING raced unhurried early, advanced inside on the upper turn, swung out and followed the winner into the stretch, finished steadily but was no match for that rival. PHEIFFER stalked the pace from the outset, offered her best bid two wide on the turn, battled the winner briefly in the upper stretch but faded in the final furlong. JUST BILL ME stalked the pace four wide, challenged three wide on the turn and slackened in the lane. FANCEE BARGAIN lagged early, rallied into the stretch but flattened out. CHRISTMAS TIME dueled from between horses to the turn and faded. R C GANGSTER lacked good early speed, tried to rally four wide on the turn but came up empty. WILD TICKLE dueled from between horses for three furlongs then gave out. MIDNIGHT RHAPSODY dueled from the rail to the stretch and had nothing left.
