Footnotes

LIT DE BET stalked the leaders to the turn, saved ground and waited patiently for room to the stretch then shot through an opening left by the runnerup in upper stretch, engaged that one for the lead to mid stretch then gradually drew away under urging. MISS OLIVIA K was under pressure while setting the pace, responded to urging to the stretch, was collared by the winner in mid stretch but had enough left to save the place. POWERS LILSIS pressed the pace to the turn, offered her best try three wide to the stretch but flattened in the final furlong. OLD WAY chased the pace early, was two wide and rallied to the stretch but lost her punch late. SING FOR GOLD was outsprinted to the turn, got fanned four wide while attempting to rally to the stretch then could not muster the needed response. RACHEL RACCOON chased the pace to the turn, was three then four wide to the stretch and also failed to make an impact in the drive. SMOOCH had no speed, got forced widest while five deep into the stretch and came up empty. MY SIRAH SIRAH pressed the pace two wide to the stretch then stopped. KATIEINTHEFASTLANE had no speed, fell back on the turn and was eased but walked off.
