MATTIE BLUE chased the pace to the turn, rallied three wide to the stretch then closed steadily in the final furlong to be along in time. SWISS LAKER GIRL set all the pace, responded and edged clear to mid stretch, resisted to deep stretch then could not stall the winner late. BIG GIRL had no speed, bid three wide to the stretch then was gaining ground willingly in the late stages. OVER MARKETED also chased the leader to the turn, saved ground to the stretch and made up ground belatedly in the final sixteenth. RISKY ALLURE pressed the pace to the turn, was between rivals to the stretch but weakened leaving mid stretch. SEDONA SPRING was hurried early to stalk the pace, saved ground to the stretch but failed to switch leads in the drive and finished evenly.
