DIXICO was in front shortly after the start to set all of the pace, met bids on the second turn, was headed a furlong out but fought back gamely to be up in the final strides. THEY CALL HIM EL was never far back, loomed three wide on the second turn, forged to the front near the furlong pole but was outfinished. HEROICALLY settled early two wide, dropped inside on the second turn but went evenly through the lane. MILAZZO was not asked for speed early, raced three wide throughout and rallied into the stretch but flattened out. MUSIC APPEAL lagged to the second turn, angled three wide into the lane but lacked the needed response. MARINE FOG pressed the pace off the rail, had his best bid between foes on the second turn then came up empty in the stretch. PHOTO SHOPPED appeared to hit the gate at the start, hopped and was steadied then unseated his rider.
