Footnotes

JILL'S SKY was in front shortly after the break and crossed over to the rail into the first turn, set all of the pace under good rating, responded to take her longest lead in the upper stretch then had just enough in reserve to hold. PRIVATE BANKING (FR) was not asked for speed early while racing three wide to the backstretch, was forced to circle rivals five wide on the second turn while launching her bid and closed steadily but a bit too late. ISLAND ESCAPE raced unhurried early while three wide to the backstretch, commenced her bid four wide on the second turn and finished steadily. WHERE'S BAILEY was unhurried early then checked off ISLAND ESCAPE on the first turn but settled, advanced inside on the second turn, was caught behind traffic in the upper stretch and checked at the furlong pole, got through between horses then closed a mild gap. MASHINA (GB) was permitted to settle within striking distance while racing just off the rail to the backstretch, remained a factor four wide on the second turn but lacked the needed response. HOT FUDGE SUNDAE stalked the pace two wide early, was fanned three wide on the second turn but came up empty in the lane. LA BALLADAR prompted the winner two wide into the lane and weakened. THE WAGES OF SIN was well placed early from the rail, raced behind heavy traffic three wide into the lane but lacked a solid rally once clear. TENSE WAGER was never a factor. HOLD THE GAME had no speed. HAKA GIRL stalked the winner from the inside for six furlongs and

gave out.
