Footnotes

PASSING GAME had no speed, chased the pace to the turn, was roused three deep to mid turn, swung out and circled five wide into the stretch, rallied when set down, got to terms with the runnerup in deep stretch then battled and got the nod. CHIPS ALL IN stalked the pace to the turn, rallied four wide to the stretch, got to terms in mid stretch, responded when hooked by the winner and was game to the line but just missed. MARSHAL MARINI had no speed, raced two wide into the turn, swung out five wide and followed the winner into the stretch but could not make an impact late. COACH SICKIE attended the pace outside a three horse spread, responded to urging to mid stretch but weakened in the final furlong and lost the show late. RUSSIAN GREEK had no speed, saved ground to the stretch but could not summon the needed response. BLUE COLLAR BOY tracked the pace between rivals early, was in tight behind horses nearing the three eighths, checked back, raced two wide to the stretch but failed to rally when asked in the drive. SHEER TALENT tracked the leaders inside of BLUE COLLAR BOY, saved ground to the stretch but weakened in the lane. SQUID dueled for the lead between rivals to the stretch then tired. JOHNNY BE MINE was a pace factor inside horses to the stretch then gave out.
