DAILY SUDS broke a bit awkwardly then settled off the pace from the rail, remained inside on the second turn to commence his bid, rallied steadily to gain command at mid stretch and drew clear driving. YOU'RE NO GOOD set all of the pace from off the rail, responded once in the stretch but slackened. COULD BE DREAM'N stalked the pace from the rail early, shifted outside YOU'RE NO GODO on the second turn and loomed a bold factor in the upper stretch but lost his punch. FREE LOVIN' settled early from off the rail, saved ground on the second turn but did not rally. BOLD MEETING was void of any early speed, angled five wide on the second turn to rally into the stretch then could not sustain his bid. PURE MOMENTUM settled early, raced three wide throughout and did not respond. OUTSHOUT stalked the pace early three wide, was fanned four wide on the second turn and gave out. STORM FLASH could not keep up and was eased in the stretch but walked off.
