Footnotes

MEZZANINE MONEY was taken in hand early and lagged to the second turn, set out after the leaders at the three eighths, circled rivals four wide to the stretch, collared SHIRAZBERRY near the furlong pole and drew clear as much the best. SHIRAZBERRY stalked the early pace, offered her bid four wide into the second turn, drew clear in the upper stretch but proved no match for the winner leaving the furlong pole. MEETING OF MINDS was permitted to settle early from the rail, remained inside on the second turn but passed only tiring horses in the lane. MOONFEST dueled from the inside to the second turn and gave out. NAHULAKI was forwardly placed early from off the rail, tried to rally three wide on the second turn but had no response. GRAND CARO LYNN steadied hard inside MOONFEST coming out of the chute and fell back, raced unhurried to the second turn, came three wide to the stretch but did not rally. PFENNING was always outrun. TEMAGAMI dueled two wide to the second turn and stopped suddenly.
