TEJON broke alertly and dueled early between horses, edged clear into the stretch then extended his advantage while being kept to his task. COUNTRY FARMER lacked good early speed, advanced four wide on the turn to be closest to the winner in the upper stretch but could make no impact. HUZUYURHUCKLEBERRY raced unhurried to the turn, shifted three wide into the lane then angled to the outside for the drive and came on to gain the show. TUCANNON lacked early speed, was fanned five wide on the turn and finished in a mild rally. TENSE BET was forwardly placed to mid turn then failed to respond while two wide into the lane. DUBLIN'S LIFFEY dueled outside the winner to the turn and gradually weakened. CHAUNCEY settled early, raced four wide on the turn and did not rally. APPRAISAL lacked early speed, came four wide to the stretch but had no rally. SON OF SKIMMING saved ground to no avail. LARSZILLA dueled inside the winner to the stretch and gave out. SAMURAI SONG had no speed.
