BIRDIE GIRL broke alertly and dueled outside MUSICAL GENIUS to the head of the lane, gradually edged away from that rival and won driving. MUSICAL GENIUS raced upside BIRDIE GIRL to vie for the lead to the upper stretch, could not match strides in the lane but held gamely for the place. TASMANIAN TANNER was slow to gain her stride, responded from just off the rail into the stretch and rallied and came through tight quarters nearing the finished. CHIQUITA GATO stalked the dueling leaders three wide to the stretch and went evenly in the final furlong. GALES ACT was permitted to settle early, tried to rally four wide on the turn but came up empty. ANYOTHER AFTERNOON raced close up from the inside early, was in the two path on the turn but did not respond. BELLGENIE had no speed then pulled up in the stretch and was vanned off.
