KRAZY FLYER lacked good early speed, advanced four wide on the turn to reach the leaders, continued to respond in the lane and was up late to win driving. DEPUTY J DUB dueled outside DOWN RIVER ROAD early, continued to battle from between horses into the lane and kept to his task in the late stages. B G'S FEVER raced unhurried early, angled five wide on the turn and finished steadily. SEE ZO GO stalked the pace from the outside, challenged three wide on the turn, led to mid stretch then was outfinished. SAINTLY I AIN'T steadied after the start and fell but but recovered and reached contention from the inside in the opening quarter, remained a factor to the deep stretch but lacked a closing response. MILANS SUN lagged early then saved ground to no avail. DOWN RIVER ROAD raced up inside after the star to duel for the lead to the stretch and stopped.
