**Footnotes**

GOLDEN LOVER was well placed to the backstretch, bid two wide on the second turn, shifted out three deep into the stretch, rallied when set down and pushed past T'S MOUNTAIN late and held off LIZZIE'S DEMAND. The latter trailed on the first turn, chased the pace to the second turn, followed the winner three wide into the stretch, shifted out in upper stretch, dug in late but could not get up late. T'S MOUNTAIN set the pace for six furlongs, responded to mid stretch, stayed gamely to deep stretch then was bested in the final fifty yards. JAMMIN LADY LOULI was outsprinted to the backstretch, settled to the second turn, offered a bid inside to briefly reach a contending position but lost her punch in the stretch. CASINO ROYALTY was allowed to the settle for a half mile, raced two wide to the stretch but weakened in the drive. MY PERFECT LADY was three then four wide to the backstretch, settled to the far turn but was forced out five wide while trying to rally to the stretch then also weakened through the lane. FULLOFCUTENESS prompted the pace for five furlongs then tired. PEARL'S RULE was four wide throughout and gave way after six furlongs. VACATION PARADISE was never a factor.
