STORM IN BLAIRSDEN zipped to the front and was clear to the backstretch, was taken in hand and rated allowing rivals to close the gap, edged away to the second turn then responded to pressure, kicked away in upper stretch and held under steady urging. C C'S DIAMOND chased the winner to the backstretch, moved up to briefly challenge leaving the five eighths, was outkicked on the second turn then could not make an impact in the stretch while saving the place. OLYMPIC FLAME trailed for six furlongs, came two wide to the stretch, did not threaten the winner but just missed second. HE'S CAGEY was outsprinted, settled inside to the second turn then continued to save ground but failed to offer the needed late response. BALLADEER chased the winner to the half, offered his best bid three wide to the stretch then could not make further progress. FASTER THAN DUKE was three wide on the first turn, settled to the half, got fanned four wide to the stretch then tired.
