SURPRISE HALO raced up outside after the break and tracked the pace in hand, offered his bid into the stretch two wide, took command and drew clear in mid stretch then had enough left to hold. CAPT. FLY HOOK was brushed early by POKER BRAD then tucked in to the rail on the first turn and raced under patient handling to the second turn, commenced his bid inside into the stretch then closed with good speed through traffic in the final furlong. R MCLENNEN was permitted to lag early, advanced outside on the backstretch, offered a bold move four wide to the stretch to loom a factor but lost much of his punch in the late stages. EPIC HONOR pressed the pace early then slipped back on the backstretch, came two wide to the stretch and came again. KERRYGOLD (FR) was never too far back from the inside, commenced his bid from off the rail on the second turn but lacked the needed response. COME BACK RONNIE was permitted to settle early from the rail but did not have any response when the real test came. JUMRON WON raced unhurried early and finished in a mild rally. POKER BRAD steadied early and settled within striking distance from the outside to the second turn and came up empty. EDNEATOR set the pace in hand to the stretch and suddenly gave way.
