ELEVEN EASY STREET was in front shortly after the start to set all of the pace, drew clear in the upper stretch and held driving. FINISH RICH IN NYC was squeezed at the start and steadied hard to fall behind, raced unhurried from off the rail to the stretch, was behind a wall of horses entering the lane, eased out and closed well to split rivals late and gain the place. LEFT BAY settled early, moved up three wide on the turn but lacked the needed rally. KATIE'S SONG lacked good early speed, was fanned four wide rallying on the turn then flattened out in the drive. KENTUCKY TALE settled early, raced two wide and between horses on the turn but did not rally. FOOL'S JOURNEY stalked the winner two wide into the stretch and gave way. A GOLDEN JET showed speed from the inside but failed to muster a closing response.
