CHIEF LITTLE MAN raced up inside in hand, eased outside BELLY BUTTON DAWN on the turn, rallied to the lead into the stretch, drew clear and held driving. SWISS SKI was permitted to settle early, moved up from off the rail on the turn, dropped inside for the drive but lacked the needed rally. MOVE OVER MARINO lagged early, raced in the two path on the turn and came on without being a serious factor. COMMON TRUST stalked the pace three wide to the stretch and weakened. BELLY BUTTON DAWN sprinted clear in the opening stages, led to the head of the lane then had nothing left.
