TIGER'S MISTRESS was content to track the leaders to the second turn, rallied when roused three wide to the stretch, pushed to the front in mid stretch and held gamely. COLLATING LADY angled in sharply in the early stages, had no speed and settled to the half, bid three wide on the second turn, swung out into the stretch then closed steadily in the drive. SITTYTWOFITTY was allowed to settle early, raced off the rail on the second turn, eased out in upper stretch and was closing ground late. CHASIN PERFECTION chase the leaders to the second turn, circled four wide on the second turn but was outfinished in the late stages. HEY MARIA attended the pace outside of PLAYFUL ARGUMENT for six furlongs, responded to remain a factor to mid stretch then lost her punch. BURLEYS LEAP was rank in the chute in the early stages, had no speed, saved ground on the second turn then was caught in tight quarters leaving mid stretch, checked and finished evenly. RUNAWAY COMET was outsprinted and settled mid pack to the second turn, bid three then four wide on the second turn but could not make an impact in the stretch. PLAYFUL ARGUMENT flashed speed early, dueled for six furlongs, responded to mid stretch then tired.
