LUSCIOUS LONNA broke alertly, set all the pace to the stretch then responded to urging and held driving. CALL THE TEN broke a bit slow and trailed to the half mile pole, bid three then four wide to the stretch, could not impact the winner but dug in late to tag OH MOLLY BRANNIGAN for second. OH MOLLY BRANNIGAN stalked the winner to the second turn, was put to a drive three wide to the stretch, could not make an impact then weakened late and was nailed for the place. MUM'S TRUCKEE chased the pace to the half, bid four wide on the second turn then flattened out through the stretch. BERTIE was off the rail chasing the pace to the second turn, remained two wide to the stretch but failed to respond through the drive. GITTEL was three wide to the backstretch, settled to the half, tried to respond two deep on the second turn but came up empty in the lane. LA CHISPA had no speed and was not a factor. PERFECT SOULMATE was outsprinted then eased down to the rail to save ground, remained inside on the second turn but gave way in the stretch.
