BEYOND BRILLIANT broke quickest then took back to be just off the dueling leaders and in hand, remained under patient handling while three wide on the turn, forged to the front under hand urging at the furlong pole and gradually increased his advantage while being put to the whip only in the final stages. EARLY FLYER dueled from the inside throughout and gave way grudgingly in the final furlong. SOMEWHAT CHILLY broke a step slow but quickly raced up from between horses to dispute the lead, remained a solid factor from between horses to mid stretch then gradually slackened. SWORDFISH broke a little slow and settled early, came two wide to the stretch and finished in a mild late rally. PACING THE CAGE was not asked for speed early, offered a menacing bid four wide on the turn but could not sustain that rally once in the stretch. CRUISIN MAN stalked the leaders from the rail to mid turn and gave out. U U STAR was never a serious factor.
