TOO MUCH HEAT contested the pace outside rivals to the turn, was two wide and responded into the stretch, kicked clear to mid stretch then held under steady urging, pulled up lame on the clubhouse turn and was vanned off. FEST TIMES GEAR was outrun to the turn, came three wide to the stretch then was making a steady late gain. COUSIN BRUNO had no speed, got fanned four wide to the stretch then also closed a gap late. GOT THE HANG OF IT stalked the pace to the turn, offered his best bid three wide to the stretch but lost his punch in the drive. TRAINSPOTTING vied between rivals to the half mile pole then bumped with OLD MASON and had to steady off the winner's heels, dropped back to last and lost any chance. OLD MASON dueled from the rail to the half mile pole, was bumped by TRAINSPOTTING nearing the three eighths, was outrun to the stretch then gave out in the drive. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the bumping incident between TRAINSPOTTING and OLD MASON near the three eighths pole but determined that TRAINSPOTTING had caused the bumping and no change was made.
