STRUT YOUR STUFF broke alertly but allowed REY LAKE the early lead and shifted outside that rival on the first turn, continued to prompt the leader into the stretch, forged to the front at the furlong pole then held her advantage gamely. WISE INVESTOR was never too far back and three wide to the backstretch, raced in traffic while remaining three wide on the second turn and finished in a steady rally. SKETCH (IRE) was well placed early from just off the rail, saved ground on the second turn, came out slightly for the drive, offered her best bid leaving the furlong pole but hung in the late stages. REY LAKE gained command into the first turn and crossed to the rail, set all of the pace into the lane and gradually weakened. BEND raced unhurried early from off the rail, dropped inside for the second turn while reaching serious contention then went evenly through the lane. SPLASHOF PANACHE stalked the pace three wide to the stretch but lacked a closing response. SAXONY took back early from the rail and raced unhurried to the second turn, came two wide to the stretch then could not offer a serious bid. SKIP'S GAL settled early, saved ground throughout and failed to threaten. HOLIDAY EVENT was well placed while three wide to the backstretch, was fanned four wide on the second turn and came up empty. UKATABEKIDDING raced wide throughout and failed to reach contention.
