### Footnotes

COCO LADY had no speed and lagged to the second turn, advanced into that bend, swung out for room then closed with a rush to tag DANGEROUS WOMAN on the line. DANGEROUS WOMAN pressed the pace to the half, rallied two wide and pushed past PAIRODICE QUEEN on the second turn, held sway to deepest stretch but was nailed on the wire. BLESS HER HEART was three wide while tracking the pace to the second turn, remained three wide to the stretch but lacked the needed response. PAIRODICE QUEEN set the pace to the backstretch, was asked to get clear and did for a brief period then was overtaken on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. MUSICAL REVIEW saved ground to the backstretch and settled mid pack to the second turn, remained inside to the stretch but came up empty in the drive. BEING WITH YOU was fanned four wide to the backstretch, had no speed then was asked into the second turn but did not respond. AGOODY TOO was fractious in the gate then broke sideways, was straightened and hustled to the first turn, raced back in the pack throughout and did not contend. EASY VOTE was allowed to settle to the half, tried to respond three wide on the second turn but did not rally. HOUSE OF GEMS was caught out four wide while stalking the pace to the backstretch, eased over to the rail for the run on the far turn but stopped after six furlongs.
