CLOSE PURSUIT flashed good speed and led to the turn, dueled inside the runnerup to the stretch, was headed in mid stretch but fought back gamely in the late stages to grab the decision. C'MON MARQUIS pressed the winner to the turn, moved alongside two wide to the stretch, took a short lead in mid stretch then battled late but could not prevail. I C SPUTNIK tracked the top two to the turn, bid inside to the stretch then could not make an impact. TAKE A HARD LOOK had no speed, was two wide into the turn, swung out four deep into the stretch but also failed to rally. CALLDEROLL chased the leaders to the turn, was three wide to the stretch then eased out for room in upper stretch but did not threaten for the win. R SEEKER also tracked the leaders, got fanned four wide on the turn and went evenly late. IRISH ROVER stalked the pace from off the rail to the stretch then weakened in the final furlong. BENEZIT was dull then was eased when hopelessly beaten but walked off.
