### Footnotes

GATHER DE JUSTICE was allowed to settle to the half, rallied in the two path into the second turn, swung five wide and continued to advance into the stretch, pushed to the front in mid stretch and edged away driving. RAISING MEMO was also settled for a half mile, saved ground while rallying on the second turn then shifted off the rail in upper stretch and was finished willingly. FOUR NINETY NINE B had no speed, was roused three wide on the second turn then made a belated run to the line. AGGRESSION was rank and forced to steady into the first turn, stalked the pace from the rail to the stretch then could not muster the needed response. THEN PLAY ON tracked the pace to the half, was fanned four wide while rallying on the second turn, dueled to mid stretch but tired in the late stages. STEALINTHEJACKPOT was close up early, came two wide to the stretch then failed to mount a serious late bid. TOP BROCCOLI set the pace for six furlongs, responded to mid stretch but weakened in the final furlong. ALWAYS SEND ROSES pressed the pace three wide to the second turn then gave out after six furlongs. BAR ROOM BRAWL gave a dull effort.
