OLD ED was pushed along early and got the lead into the first turn, led to the half mile pole, turned back MOSCATO into the second turn, responded and edged clear to mid stretch then was kept to task in the lane. SMOOTH AND SAVVY was three wide to the backstretch, chased the winner to the second turn, came two wide to the stretch, could not impact the winner but wore down MOSCATO for second. MOSCATO was forced out four deep on the first turn, pressed the pace to the half, offered a bid outside the winner at the seven sixteenths, was outkicked on the turn then weakened and gave up the place late. FOLLOWS NONE stalked the pace early, was within striking distance to the second turn, was caught four wide to the stretch and came up empty in the drive. PLATINUM KATILLAC had no speed, raced three wide on the second turn and failed to rally. KASH'S KOMET was outsprinted and settled mid pack, tried to rally from the two path on the second turn but gave out in the drive. SCIRMISH was also outsprinted, settled to the second turn, was three deep to the stretch but tired in the lane. QUASIMODO was always outrun.
