GREAT NEWS was well placed off the pace to the turn, got outkicked to the stretch, responded to pressure in the drive, collared the leader leaving mid stretch and held driving. ROYALLY LARGE set all the pace, kicked away to a clear lead into the stretch then was tiring late, could not stall the winner but saved second. BLOOM TIME prompted the pace to the turn, raced three wide to the stretch then kept to task but was not a serious threat. ADAYFORPICKNDAISYS had no speed, raced off the rail to the stretch then shifted out in upper stretch and made up ground belatedly. MARIAH MARINA tracked the pace to the turn, got fanned out four wide to the stretch then went evenly through the final furlong. OLD WAY had no speed, was also pushed out four wide to the stretch and had a mild late rally. MISS LYDIA tracked the pace to the turn, came two wide to the stretch but lacked the needed closing response. NO CREAM OR SUGAR chased the pace to the turn then saved ground to no avail.
