Footnotes

FU PEG HE RAT was forwardly placed from the outset without needed of coaxing, crossed to the rail on the first turn and remained there, was boxed on the second turn, got through inside SUDDEN EXCESS entering the lane, collared WESTERN ROSES inside the furlong pole and outbattled that rival to the line. WESTERN ROSES broke alertly but allowed SUDDEN EXCESS to take a clear early lead and stalked that rival, moved up from the three path on the second turn, took command nearing the furlong pole, battled the winner but could not quite match strides. STORMY SURGE was permitted to settle early, advanced two wide and between horses on the second turn but flattened out once in the stretch. QUASICOBRA lagged to the stretch, came to the outside and passed horses without being a serious threat. RENZO SEAN was well placed early from off the rail, tried to rally three wide into the stretch but lacked the needed response. CHIEF RUNAWAY settled early, offered a menacing move four wide and outside RENZO SEAN on the second turn but had little left once in the stretch. SUDDEN EXCESS took a clear lead on the first turn from off the rail and set all the pace to the second turn and gave out.
