CIMMARON KID settled mid pack for a half, made a stout run three wide on the second turn then continued to respond in the stretch and got the nod on the line. CODYS A BOBCAT pressed the pace to the second turn, came two wide to the stretch, seemed to hanging in mid stretch then dug in when the winner went by him a sixteenth out and surged late to just miss. MACHO DORADO set all the pace for five furlongs, was put to a drive on the second turn, responded gamely to deep stretch but was bested. SEVENTEENMILEDRIVE chased the pace from the two path to the second turn, was a factor to upper stretch but came up empty late. WIN FOR ANNIE DEAR broke slow, had no speed, was two wide to the stretch and did not rally. TURBULENT CREEK had no speed and was not a factor. HEY WHY NOT tracked the pace from the rail to the second turn then gave out.
