BATTLE LOU was never far back inside a bunched up pack, eased off the rail on the turn to advance outside the leaders into the lane, rallied steadily in the lane from the outside to gain command late and won going away driving. FORMULA GOLD was very fractious in the warm up period, throwing his rider three times, then broke in mid pack and slipped back in traffic nearing the half mile pole, rallied between horses on the turn, came out for the drive and finished steadily. GHOST REIGN dueled from the rail to mid stretch and faltered. GRADY'S SMILE settled early, saved ground on the turn and finished willingly from the inside. BAILOUTTHEMINISTER stalked the dueling leaders three wide, slipped back on the turn but kept to his task in the lane. SUNDAY COMIC broke slow and lacked any early speed, saved ground on the turn, angled out for the drive and closed a gap. KNOW THE FLAME dueled two wide into the stretch and gave way. WINTER'S GRAND settled early, drifted four wide on the turn and came up empty. GRAND TAKEOVER raced close up from the outside early, was floated out to the five path on the turn and never responded.
