TOOMUCHISNOTENOUGH broke alertly, dueled outside of SUMMER SUNRISE to the stretch, pushed clear to mid stretch then edged away to the line. MARLA HOOCH tracked the leaders to the turn, came two wide to the stretch, was outkicked to mid stretch but kept to task and was up for second. SEVEN STORMS had no speed, raced two wide to the stretch then eased out for room and was making a bit of bid late. LEXIE ARLEEN was pinched between the winner and SUMMER SUNRISE in the opening strides and checked, chased the pace to the turn, bid three wide and rallied to mid stretch then lost her punch. K K'S WONDERWOMAN had no speed, tried to respond while three deep to the stretch but came up empty. SUMMER SUNRISE was hustled and dueled inside the winner, saved ground to the stretch then tired. PAY THE DEBT stalked the leaders in the opening quarter, dropped back inside to the stretch then gave out.
