Footnotes

BROKE IN BLAIRSDEN was permitted to settle to the turn, began to rally leaving the three eighths, was fanned six wide into the stretch but rallied to the lead at the furlong marker then inched away under steady urging. POWER TO BURN broke in a tangle but was hustled early and tracked the leaders, shifted out into the stretch and bumped LEFA THEDA lightly, responded once clear but could not impact the winner. FULL MOON LADY dueled from the rail to the stretch, responded to urging to mid stretch but was tiring late. OUR MANGO dueled outside OF FULL MOON LADY to the stretch, also responded to mid stretch then weakened late. WOODFORD PRINCESS had no speed, saved ground while advancing on the turn, shifted out in upper stretch and had a mild late run. LEFA THEDA dueled for the lead to the turn, remained with the leaders to the stretch, was bumped lightly nearing the three sixteenths then lacked a closing response. SENFULLY EASY contested the pace to the turn, was four then five wide to the stretch and came up empty. LADY EVERGREEN 7was allowed to settle but did not threaten. A claim of foul by the rider on LEFA THEDA for alleged interference into the stretch was not allowed by the stewards.
