SWISS LAKER GIRL was hustled to the front, set the pace from the rail to the stretch then responded to urging, kicked away to mid stretch and was under a drive to the line. FORGOTTEN PEARL stalked the pace early, was outkicked from the rail on the turn then was no threat to the winner while besting the rest. COOL TODDY chased the pace to the turn, bid three wide to the stretch then could not muster the needed late response. CHE CHE was hurried in the early stages but was outsprinted by the winner and raced green behind that one in the opening quarter mile, dropped back to last, swung out four wide mid turn then showed late interest in a better-than-looked debut. PRINCESS REDA pressed the pace outside the winner to the stretch but weakened through the final furlong. INTRIGUING had no speed, offered her best bid three wide to the stretch but faded in the drive.
