Footnotes

MISS CALIFORNIA broke alertly and stalked the pace from the two path into the stretch, rallied determinedly to gain command just past mid stretch and won driving. FOGGY DEW lacked early speed from the three path, circled rivals four wide on the second turn to loom a bold factor near the furlong pole and flattened out in the lane. EXCESSIVE FASHION tracked the pace from off the rail but could not make an impact until the final stages. OLYMPIC STARTER set all of the pace from the inside, responded in the land and gave way late. RUNNING FOR JAKOB settled early from the rail, remained inside to rally into the stretch then lost her punch. CAMPEENYA lagged early, was two wide on both turns then failed to rally. ACES AND DEUCES saved ground to no avail. SMILES CONTAGIOUS settled early from the rail, remained inside on the second turn but had no response. SHEANA MALAENA settled in mid pack and off the rail early then gave way three wide on the second turn.
