SISTER GLADY OH LA was unhurried for a half mile, bid four wide and followed the runnerup on the second turn, eased out another path into the stretch, rallied when set down and wore down LADY ASPEN late. LADY ASPEN was also unhurried, offered a good run four wide on the second turn, collared SWEETLY PEPPERED in mid stretch, was briefly clear nearing the sixteenth marker then could not stall the winner. SWEETLY PEPPERED tracked the pace to the half, rallied three wide on the second turn, engaged for the lead into the stretch, was collared by the runnerup in mid stretch and weakened. LIGHT UP THE SKY never far back to the second turn, raced off the rail to the stretch but could not muster the needed response. HANDFULL pressed the pace to the second turn, got fanned out four wide while being roused to the stretch then gave way in the drive. COUP DE COEUR set the pace for six furlongs, was overtaken into the stretch and tired. DARK DOLORES trailed throughout.
