**Footnotes**

SOUND OF MONEY chased the leaders to the turn, was outside a rival to the stretch, shifted out in upper stretch and rallied when clear to collar the runnerup late. BLUE JAY ATTACK tracked the pace to the turn, saved ground to the stretch, rallied to the lead in mid stretch, dug in gamely when confronted by the winner but was bested late. LAST DRAW got outsprinted early, raced three wide to the stretch, angled in towards the rail in mid stretch and was closing ground well. TRUENO was also outsprinted, got fanned four wide to the stretch then was making up some ground belatedly. PARTY AT MY PLACE contested the pace outside of SIDEPOCKET LOU, raced two wide to the stretch then was outkicked to mid stretch and weakened. THE TOUR DIRECTOR had no speed, raced three wide on the turn but failed to offer the needed response. SIDEPOCKET LOU showed good speed early, dueled from the rail to the stretch but gave way in the final furlong. LETHARGIC was a pace factor three wide to the stretch then tired. KNOWN ASSOCIATE had no speed and saved ground to no avail. MR RONALD V. CLOUD also had no speed, was fanned out four deep on the turn but never threatened.
