Footnotes

SIDEPOCKET CAT was well placed to the half, bid three wide on the second turn, set out after CASE STUDY once straightened for the drive and gradually wore that one down to get the nod. CASE STUDY set the pace while racing off the rail to the stretch, responded to mid stretch, held the lead to deep stretch but could not hold off the winner. STARCAST tracked the pace three wide to the stretch then made up ground belatedly. POWERFUL PETE had no speed, was three wide to the stretch and lacked the needed response. ELIMINATOR tracked the pace to the second turn, tried to respond two wide to the stretch but came up empty in the drive. ALPHA LUCKY saved ground to no avail. HARD ALEE was hard to load then was fractious in the gate and broke a bit slow, settled mid pack to the second turn but had little to offer when roused. OCEAN MELODY was always outrun then eased eased in the stretch but walked off. AT THE BADA BING stalked the pace, saved ground to the stretch but stopped suddenly and was eased but walked off.
