HUDSON LANDING broke alertly then settled in just off the two leaders, moved up three wide on the second turn, rallied determinedly through the lane and was up in the final stride. CONTROL SEEKER prompted GLADDING from the outside for six furlongs, took command when that rival faltered into the stretch, responded gamely when the rider dropped his hip near the furlong pole and gave way grudgingly. FAST TRACK was not asked for speed to the second turn, saved ground to the stretch, came to the outside for the drive and closed best. POSITIVE RESPONSE was well positioned from the rail from the outset, remained under restraint on the second turn while behind a wall of horses,, offered his bid from the rail to mid stretch but lacked the needed response. DUKE OF DOOM raced unhurried early from off the rail, circled rivals four wide on the second turn to loom a bold factor but lost his punch in the stretch. GLADDING stumbled a bit at the start but quickly recovered and set the pace from the inside to the head of the lane and stopped.
