SUMMER LASS was outrun early but advanced steadily three wide, took over mid turn, responded gamely to strong urging and held off CHARLOTTE FOREVER late. CHARLOTTE FOREVER had no speed, rallied three wide to the stretch, responded when straightened, made a steady run in the drive but missed. MOYANNA (IRE) stalked the pace from the rail to the stretch but could not threaten the top two. PAPIER MACHE had no speed and could only pick off rivals late. PEM'S HOSTESS pressed the pace two wide to the turn, dropped back to the stretch and finished evenly late. TRISH'S CAJUN raced mid pack early then was caught behind horses and hard to place, shifted out, tried to split rivals leaving the half mile pole but was squeezed off and had to steady hard then came up empty. SUMMER SAILS sped clear soon after the start, was caught mid turn then gave out.
