Footnotes

UNUSUAL TALENT was unhurried for a half mile, was boxed behind rivals on the second turn, waited to the stretch then eased out for room at the three sixteenths, rallied when clear and was along in time to tie for the win. AERIAL ARTIST stalked the pace to the second turn, bid inside to the stretch, pushed to the front in mid stretch, led to deep stretch then was caught in the final stride in a dead heat. MOSES ON THE MESA was on the pace from the rail for a half, raced two wide while responding on the second turn, was overtaken in mid stretch, weakened but saved the show. CANE SEEKER raced unhurried to the second turn, circled rivals five wide to the stretch then finished willingly but could not make an impact. QUACKIN trailed to the second turn, bid three then four wide to the stretch, eased widest in the drive and was gaining ground belatedly. WE CAN BE HEROES attended the pace outside of MOSES ON THE MESA, raced three wide to the stretch then tired. OUR WORTHYENDEAVOR stalked the pace to the second turn, was four wide then began to tire after six furlongs, checked off heels at the three sixteenths and stopped.
