Footnotes

FUNI ACT settled mid pack to the half, bid two then three wide to the stretch, rallied in the drive and pushed clear late. THE TOUR DIRECTOR had no speed, settled to the second turn, bid three wide then shifted out in upper stretch, could not find room and had to steady nearing the sixteenth marker then closed well once clear late. SPEED ROUSER stalked the leaders to the second turn, bid three wide to the stretch, loomed a threat to mid stretch but could not sustain the needed response. SUMMER SUNSHINE pressed the action to the backstretch, moved up to engage for the lead after a half, was two wide to the stretch, battled to mid stretch but was weakening late. TWAIN'S TITAN saved ground early, settled to the second turn, came two wide to the stretch then finished steadily late. VISUAL INTENSITY had no speed, bid three then four wide on the second turn, swung widest in upper stretch but lost his punch in the latter stages. CLASSICAL BARTOK was mid pack for a half mile, tried to rally from the three path to the stretch but came up empty. RENZO SEAN

was well placed from the rail to the second turn but tired in the drive. RED COATS R COMIN set the pace in the early stages, dueled for the lead from the rail to mid stretch then tired. LIQUID ASSET never far back, saved ground to the stretch but weakened through the lane. SEEKING SOLACE had no speed and was outrun.
