OMAR was hustled to the front, set the pace while off the rail to the stretch then responded gamely to pressure and held. TRUMPET PLAYER JAY pressed the winner to the turn, was roused three wide to the stretch, loomed to mid stretch but was outfinished late. COST OF FREEDOM chased the leaders to the turn, saved ground and rallied up to loom boldly in mid stretch but hung in the final sixteenth. LORNEFIVEHUNDRED was outsprinted to the turn, raced two wide to the stretch then failed to offer the needed response. SOURDOUGH SAM had no speed, saved ground on the turn and was making up ground belatedly. A PINT FOR MARY chased the pace three wide to the stretch then weakened. SUCCESSFUL BLUFF was very awkward when the latch was sprung and came out four lengths behind, had no speed, was fanned four wide to the stretch and tired.
